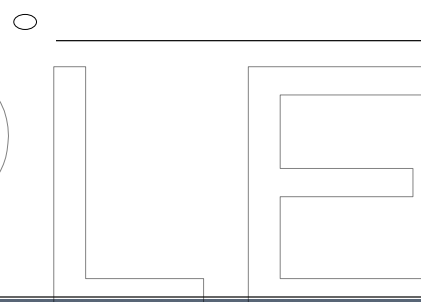

**County Measure No. 1**

As per N.D.C.C. 57-15-06-7(2), shall the governing body of Ramsey County, State of North Dakota, maintain the additional 2 mills for Ramsey County Extension above the 2 mill levy limitations set out in the N.D.C.C. 11-38-01(2) for a total of 4 mills.

The Ramsey County Extension provides the public with information & educational opportunities in the area of crop & livestock production, horticulture, 4-H youth development, family & community wellness.

**County Measure No. 2**

Shall the County of Ramsey, State of North Dakota, continue to levy 10.00 mills, in accordance with N.D.C.C. 57-15-06.3, on the net taxable valuation of all property in the County, for construction, repairs and maintenance of County Farm to Market and CMC Routes (County Major Collectors). Said levy is not subject to the County Mill Levy Limitations. This levy to have an effective date of August 1, 2024.

**County Measure No. 3**

As per N.D.C.C. 57-15-06-7(5), shall the governing body of Ramsey County continue to levy an additional 10 mills, on the net taxable valuation of all property in the County, for County Road and Bridges, which is above the 10 mill levy limitation set out in the N.D.C.C. 57-15-06.7 for a total of 20 mills? This levy to have an effective date of August 1, 2024.

**Devils Lake City Measure No. 1**

Shall the Home Rule Charter of the City of Devils Lake be amended to empower the City Commission to impose an additional tax of up to one quarter of one percent (0.25%) on sales at retail, storage, use or consumption of personal property, and sales of alcoholic beverages within the City. This increase shall be distributed to the Devils Lake Park Board for infrastructure projects.

Shall the City of Devils Lake sales tax increase an additional 0.25% to be dedicated to the Devils Lake Park Board to fund community recreational infrastructure projects?
